

Product certification

- Written assurance (=a certificate) by an independent body that a product meets specific requirements.
(also applies to services or systems)
- Link with EPC input data:
 - Certification provides trustworthy data
 - Are they compliant data (do they comply with the procedures of the legislation) ?
 - In some cases, certification provides compliant data. In France, certified product data give a bonus in the calculation

Database

- Certified product database
- Database of declared data, with control of an evidence of compliance
- Provide an easy access to EPC input data
- Compliance with the regulation: depends on the procedures of the legislation to determine data

EPC input data

- Not a unique set of data for all national EPB regulations
- Input data for Ecodesign regulations are not always the same
- Should we go towards a unique set of input data?
- Is a unique European calculation method a utopian dream?
